Security Tips in Restaurants

Recently, several restaurants in Sao Paulo city and its frequenters have become targets of "Steaming" during the establishments working hours. The criminals are choosing to attack high standard establishments located in high class neighborhood of the capital, where victims are found with greater purchasing power. In view of this new type of crime, the Nucleo Consultoria experts offers tips on how not to be the next victim in a restaurant "Steaming": **1.** Prefer large locals, glazed and bright, they are less likely to be the target, rather than discreet restaurants in desert streets, where nobody sees what goes on inside. **2.** Avoid the closing time in restaurants between 22 pm and midnight (period of highest occurrence incidence), when the cash out becomes more attractive and the little

movement on the streets makes it easy to escape. **3.** Choose locations with private parking and security. **4.** If possible, make sure the valet employee works at the establishment. **5.** Do not meet alone a strangers approach at your table requesting or reporting changes to your vehicle parked on a public street, it can be a trap for the accomplishment of a robbery or a kidnapping. **6.** Avoid carrying objects that attract attention, such as jewelry and watches. **7.** Minimize losses: bring only one or two credit cards, identity documents and a small amount of money. **8.** Women who have to take a purse should prefer a more discreet one, smaller and shoulder bag.

Commented Synopsis: The film is a fiction work, inspired by the biggest bank robbery of the century. The movie ranges aspects such as the robbery gang preparation and the federal police backstage investigation. In August 2005, 164.7 million BRL (80.9 million dollars) were stolen from the Fortaleza City Central Bank, Ceara state. Without taking a single shot, without triggering an alarm, the robbers entered and exited through an 84 meters tunnel dug under the safe taking with them three tons of money. The whole operation took three months and a lot of money was spent in the planning. It was one of the most sophisticated and well designed crimes that had already been noticed in Brazil. Who were these people? And what happened to them afterwards? These are questions that have been done since then. "If you have not watched this movie, watch! An interesting, real, with major repercussions in our Brazil story, told in a dynamic mode, which alternate moments of tension, violence and humor". **Marcela Floriano**
